

Resolution in Opposition to McClellan-Palomar Airport Master Plan Update and in Support of Citizens for a Friendly Airport

WHEREAS in October 2018, the San Diego County Board of Supervisors approved a plan to greatly expand the McClellan-Palomar Airport and allow much larger planes to use the airport despite the growth of neighborhoods, schools, offices and healthcare centers around what was always predicated to be a general aviation airport.


WHEREAS data provided for the Program Environmental Impact Report (PEIR) was flawed leading to insufficient environmental studies on nearly all aspects of the plan resulting in increased pollution (greenhouse gases, lead), noise, and unstable extended runway if the plan is implemented.

WHEREAS Citizens for a Friendly Airport, a nonprofit advocacy group of concerned residents since 2017, has engaged an attorney and taken legal action against the San Diego County Board of Supervisors for the flawed data provided for the PEIR to prevent the plan from being implemented.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Democratic Club of Carlsbad Oceanside (DEMCCO) opposes the new McClellan-Palomar Airport Master Plan Update and supports the Citizens for a Friendly Airport's legal action against this plan.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Democratic Club of Carlsbad Oceanside (DEMCCO) supports Citizens for a Friendly Airport and their efforts to insure that McClellan-Palomar Airport remain a community-friendly airport.
