

Resolution in Support of Increased State Education Funding of Special Education

WHEREAS, funding mechanisms for Special Education services is inadequate and unequal,

WHEREAS, federal and state law requires a free and appropriate public education for some children from birth to age 22 but there is currently no mechanism for funding programs for preschool-aged students, and

WHEREAS, some services required by students with severe disabilities are high cost and funding in current law does not account for these extra costs,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Democratic Club of Carlsbad Oceanside (DEMCCO) supports AB 428: An Act to Amend Special Education Funding which improves the mechanism and amount of Special Education funding; allows for funding of classes for students aged 3 and 4 years; and provides an allowance for high cost services, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Democratic Club of Carlsbad Oceanside (DEMCCO) will communicate with Assemblymember Tasha Boerner Horvath and State Senator Patricia Bates our support of AB 428 and urge them to vote for the passage of this bill.
