

# DEMCCO General Meeting Minutes

**January 25, 2020**

Member Nadine Scott announced the nominating committee for the election of DEMCCO officers including 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice Presidents, Secretary, Fundraising Chair, Communications Chair, Hospitality Chair, 3 members of the Nominating Committee, and Political Action Chair. - I. The meeting was called to order by Linda Slater at 10:00 AM, who then led us in the Pledge of Allegiance.
- II. The meeting agenda was approved without objection.
- III. The minutes from October 2019 meeting were approved without objection.
- IV. Parliamentarian David Hall welcomed new members and visitors. He also requested all to observe the bylaws and Roberts Rules of Order, follow the time clock and save passions for electing democrats.
- V. Linda Slater announced a new Coordinated Campaign Office on Oceanside Blvd, at 1305 Union Plaza Court. Hugh McGrane is the SD County Field manager. Kick off is 2/1/20 9AM -1PM and all are welcome.

  - c. Measure B – DEMCCO approved a resolution to oppose Newland Sierra on 10/26/2019.
  - d. Measure K – Shall the City appoint its Clerk and Treasurer (Oceanside only). DEMCCO approved a resolution to oppose this on 9/28/2019.
  - e. 9 Candidates running for the SD County Central Committee spoke. Only 6 seats are open.
  - f. Presidential candidates – members spoke on behalf of Elizabeth Warren (Bob Spencer), Bernie Sanders (Eric Joyce), and Duval Patrick (Richard Jaross).
  - g. Congressman Mike Levin, 49<sup>th</sup> District, gave an update of local activities and actions in DC. The polls show 44-44% tie with the Republican opponent in the district and we need a blue tsunami. Members were encouraged to join the Mike Levin team to canvass in Carlsbad after the meeting.
