

DEMCCO Special Meeting Minutes

October 9, 2021

- I. The Zoom meeting was called to order by President Linda Slater at 10:05 AM with 38 participants. She welcomed everyone.
The agenda as provided in the meeting announcement was accepted since this is a Special Meeting called to hold votes for an endorsement and a resolution.

- II. Consideration of an Endorsement in the Oceanside City Council District 1 Race
 - a) Candidates Remarks: Eric Joyce outlined his experience and goals including open space and clean air, jobs in Oceanside, a bikeable community, bringing community trust back to the council. Wants to bring the voice of the people to council.

 - b) Questions: Climate Action Plan? Yes should have plan and targets. Do you have a position on South Morro Hills and potential for another 6000 homes? He will stand behind the voters and not support sprawl in SMH. Will you vote to leave SMH at 2.5 acre/house and not support cluster housing and density transfer. His answer is yes. Will you support the Climate Action, Smart Corridor Plan, Agritourism Plan vs voting for variances that against these plan? Yes he will support the plans vs succumbing to pressure from other council members or developers and if the plan needs to be changed, change the plan.

 - c) There were 4 speakers in favor of endorsement and no speaker against endorsement.

 - d) Voting was held by Zoom with members not on Zoom, voting by texting Shirley Anderson. The vote was: yes 40, no 0, no endorsement 0. Eric Joyce was endorsed unanimously.

 - e) Motion: Kathy Rawlings moved to donate \$500 and then withdrew here motion. She then moved to donate \$1000 and Ann Crosbie seconded. Linda Slater made a stipulation to not give the money until after the Registrar of Voters verifies for certain there will be a special election. The motion passed unanimously.

- III. Consideration of a resolution entitled: Resolution in Support of the Recall Special Election of Oceanside City Council District 1 Appointee Kori Jensen aka Page.
The resolution was submitted by Nadine Scott per SD Democratic Party Policy and Procedures guidelines. Janet Lacey wanted to amend the resolution to include the details of her purgery with regard to her living address. Roger Davenport will email Janet the details. Mike Bullock that the title be changed to recalling Kori Jensen. Ann Crosbie supports modifying the title. Jane Marshall called the questions "to agree to adopt the resolution to support the recall of Kori Jensen. Resolution passed 31 voting yes with 3 opposed.

- IV. Announcements:
 - Kathy Rawlings and Ann Crosbie requested members' ideas for December Holiday Fundraiser with alcohol and asked if anyone would open their home or clubhouse for either the first two weeks in December. Ann Corsbie also requested we all consider other spaces including outdoor.
