WHEREAS The San Diego County Democratic Party Plank states: "We honor, celebrate, and support a diverse California, including immigrant and indigenous communities, veterans, artists, children and seniors, and will work to ensure they receive all needed resources.", and,

WHEREAS The California Democratic Party Plank States: "Protect the constitutional and sovereign rights of Native American Nations and well-established rights and jurisdictions of California Native American tribes; respect a tribe's sovereign powers in protecting Native American land, labor, resources, including sources of drinking water, sacred sites and ancestral burial grounds", and,
