1<sup>st</sup> Democrat to run for re-election in Oceanside in 134 years; going to be community based election

### **8. Program: Affordable Housing Crisis Panel (10:30 – 11:30 am)**

Denise Saiz, 1st VP, introduced our two speakers. Brian McDonnell is a Case Manager for Interfaith Community Services, a non-profit “that began as a movement dedicated to bringing people together and providing compassion for people in crisis, no matter the circumstances ” presented their perspective on the affordable housing crisis.

Dr. Inez Williams is Chair of Housing Commission for Oceanside which brings recommendations to the city council. Carmela Munoz, a community organizer who is the voice of Oceanside’s Crown Heights Neighborhood, had been scheduled to speak as well but was unable to join us at the last moment.

Mr. McDonnell discussed his work with TBRA (tenant based rental assistance). Dr. Williams discussed the commission’s advocacy for increasing the inclusionary housing fees for developers to provide more affordable housing. .
